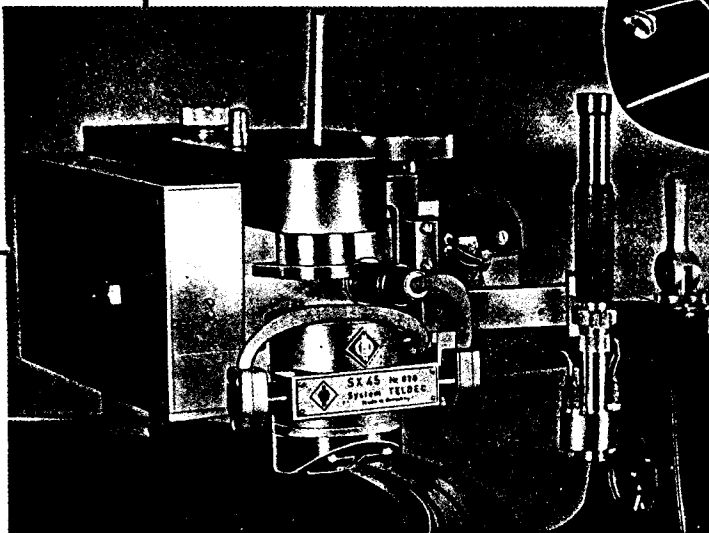
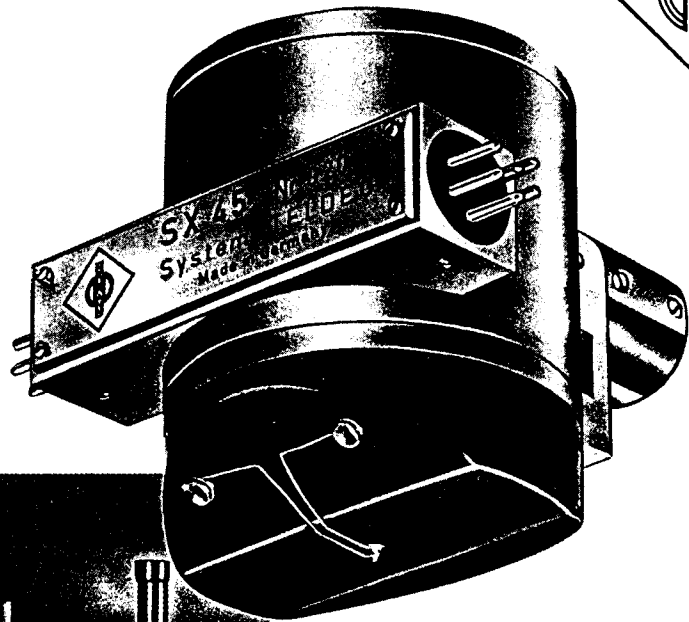


DYNAMIC STEREO FEEDBACK CUTTERHEAD SX-45

(SYSTEM NEUMANN-TELDEC)

The newest stereo feedback cutterhead SX-45 is the latest in a series of stereophonic cutters going back to 1955, when the TELDEC Company (a joint venture of English Decca and Telefunken) and NEUMANN produced the first two-component stereophonic recording feedback cutterhead of the current era. Its 17 oz. weight and miniature dimensions make it the smallest such device in the world — a tremendous advantage since no advance ball is necessary, and depth control can be effected without mechanical interference with the cutter suspension. The SX-45 in contrast to its predecessor, the ZS-90/45, is a basic 45/45 system. This means that each of the drive systems produces motion at 45 degrees to the record surface without necessity for matrixing.
