
DYNAMIC STEREO FEEDBACK CUTTERHEAD SX-45

The newest stereo feedback cutterhead SX-45 is the latest in a series of stereophonic cutters going back to 1955, when the TELDEC Company (a joint venture of English Decca and Telefunken) and NEUMANN produced the first twocomponent stereophonic recording feedback cutterhead of the current era. Its 17 oz. weight and miniature dimensions make it the smallest such device in the world — a tremendous advantage since no advance ball is necessary, and depth control can be effected without mechanical interference with the cutter suspension. The SX-45 in contrast to its predecessor, the ZS-90/45, is a basic 45/45 system. This means that each of the drive systems produces motion at 45 degrees to the record surface without necessity for matrixing.
